

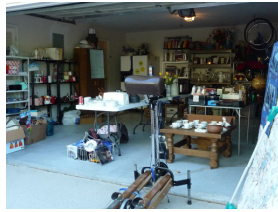

Children of Zion Village Updates

There is a new baby at Children of Zion Village. Fortune, the school principle, and his wife welcomed their baby girl - Ariel Ndione into the world on April 6. At 6:30am they headed to the hospital in the boat and she was born at 11:00 at the hospital! She became the youngest person to get a ride in the boat since the road was still not open due to flooding.

Ten of our older children are receiving training at the local Vocational College, plus one is interning with a plumber and another helping at a travel agency. Thank you to the local Katima Mulilo community for supporting the growth and independence of our children!

The Zambezi River rose again, adding more water on the flooded roads. It may be awhile before we are able to get to work repairing the road and bridge leading to Children of Zion Village. In the meantime our boat is working overtime, as the river is the only access in and out of our property. **Please pray for safety and that the waters recede quickly.**

Goty and Petro have been playing soccer on a regional adult team and have been offered spots on a team traveling to Windhoek this week to play in the televised Coca-Cola Cup.
