Global Outreach Weekend

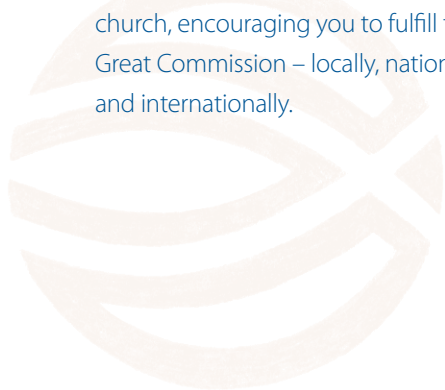
The purpose of the Global Outreach Weekend is to begin the mobilization process by helping your church discover God's heart for the world and to join God on mission through a personalized and strategic plan for local, national, and international outreach. The weekend is designed to introduce effective means of mobilizing the entire congregation for mission.

The weekend includes a six-hour seminar (the Global Outreach Seminar) as well as ministry to the entire congregation in Sunday worship and Sunday school classes or small groups. This weekend

will help bring a deeper understanding of the biblical basis of global missions, a greater awareness of the world, and a challenge to greater involvement in outreach both locally and internationally.

Mentoring Services

Helping you move from vision to reality, an experienced missions mentor will come alongside you to help your church fully implement the strategies introduced in the seminar. You will receive hands-on guidance on incorporating a global vision and a commitment to mission into every area of your church's life.



Workshops

In addition to the mentoring service, we offer two-day workshops on foundational elements introduced in the seminar. These workshops are designed to equip church leadership to immediately begin implementing the concepts and strategies that are taught.

This interactive training will equip leaders to develop and execute an effective short-term missions plan, and to train and disciple the members of their short-term mission teams.

Global Outreach Leadership Seminar
